

Steps to Generate an Application Password (Google)

The steps required to generate an application password are described below.

1. Access your Google Account Settings

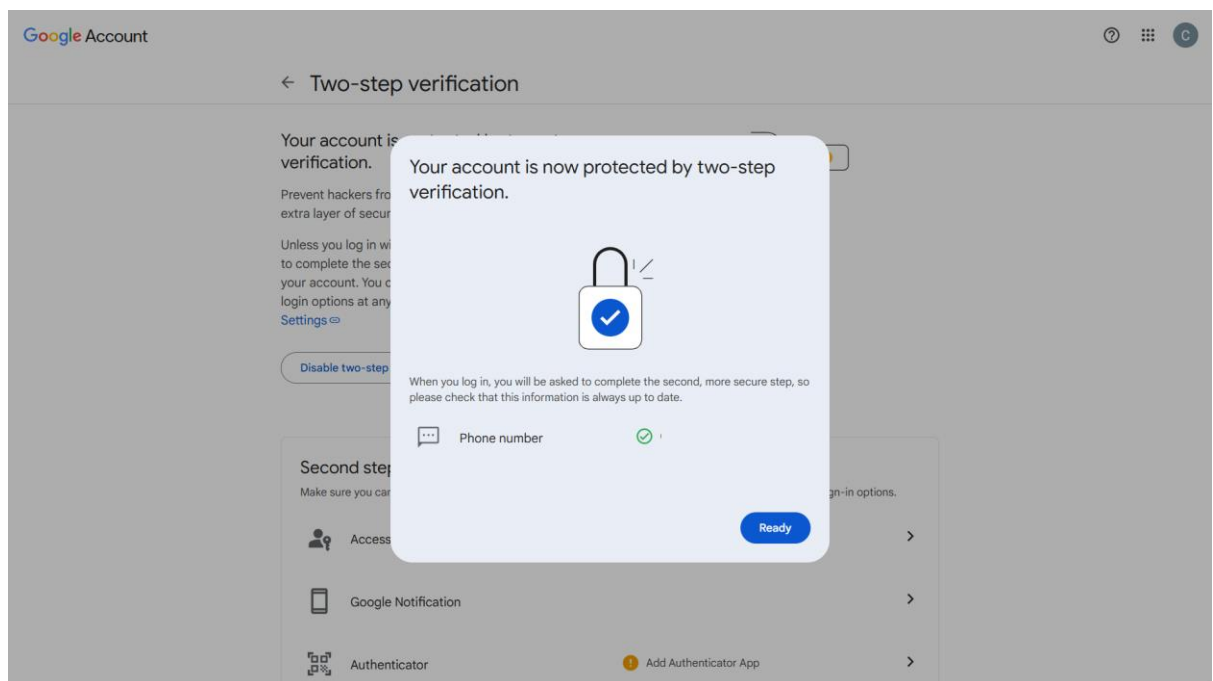
- Enter the following link <https://myaccount.google.com>.
- Sign in with the Google account you want to set up.

2. Activate Two-Step Verification

- In the left side menu, select "**Security**".
- In the section "**How do you sign in to Google**", locate the option "**Two-step verification**" and click on "**Ready**".
- Follow the procedure to link an authentication device, such as a mobile phone.

This feature adds an extra layer of security, as any attempt to access from an unrecognized app or device will require additional verification.

If the configuration was successful, the following message should be displayed.

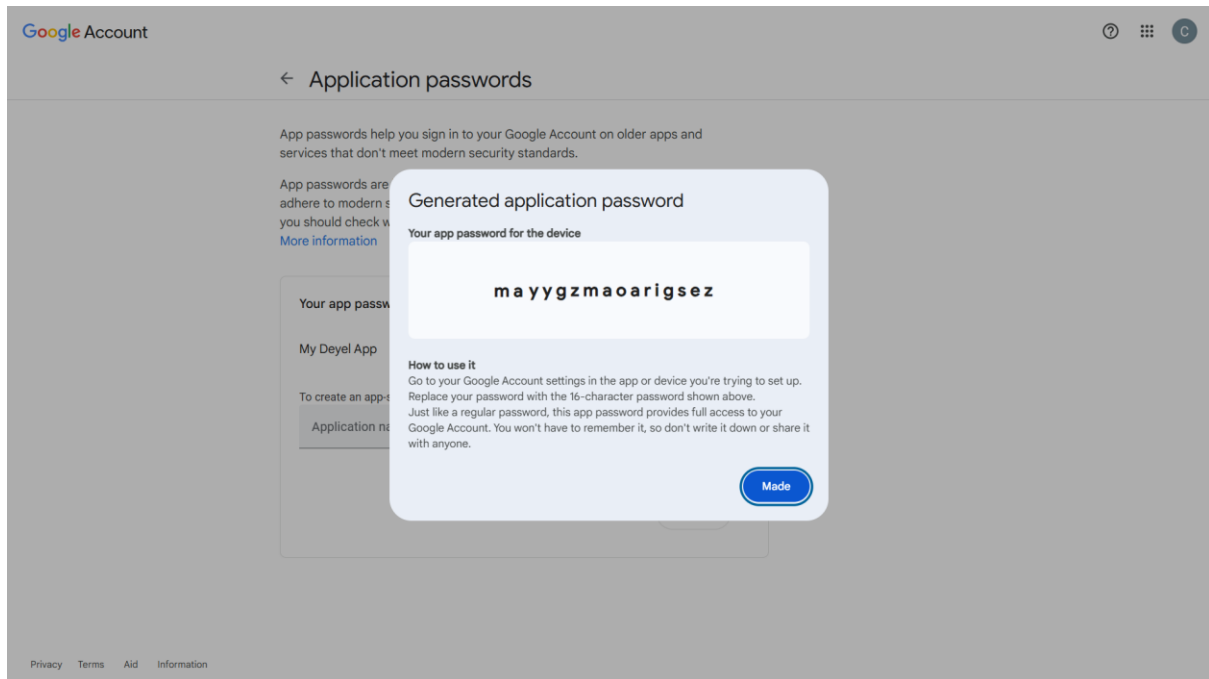


Note: If the two-step verification is already active, you can proceed directly to the next step.

3. Generate the Application Password

- Enter to <https://myaccount.google.com/apppasswords>.
- You may be asked to enter your password again.
- In the field **Application name** enter a descriptive name, such as: "**My Deyel App**", and click on "**Made**".

- A 16-character password will be displayed. Copy this password, as you won't be able to see it again.



⚠ **Important:** Copy the application password immediately. For security reasons, it **will not be able to be displayed again** once the window is closed. If you lose it, you will have to generate a new one.
